1. Uranium excretion experiments (urine) designed to test the effectiveness of respirators (gas masks, etc.) in filtering out radioactive dust, gas and smoke.
2. Work involving the installation, maintenance or repair of stationary air samplers, located in various production and non-production areas, as well as portable air samplers.
3. Work involving neptunium (code named "trace") recovery operations in Building C-710.

McMurry, who is investigating radiation control practices at the Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant as lead counsel for the plaintiffs in the worker lawsuit pending in the United States District Court against Union Carbide, Martin Marietta, Lockheed Martin and General Electric.
